

The School Grade Report Card contains several types of data designed to inform parents and the general public about the progress of Florida’s public schools. This report meets the public reporting requirements of the federal No Child Left Behind and includes certain additional information of interest on the status of Florida’s schools.

Reading and Mathematics Assessment: On the FSA reading, mathematics and FCAT science tests, students can attain one of five possible achievement levels, ranging from level 1 (lowest) to level 5 (highest). **The charts below show the percent of students scoring at Level 3 and above.**
